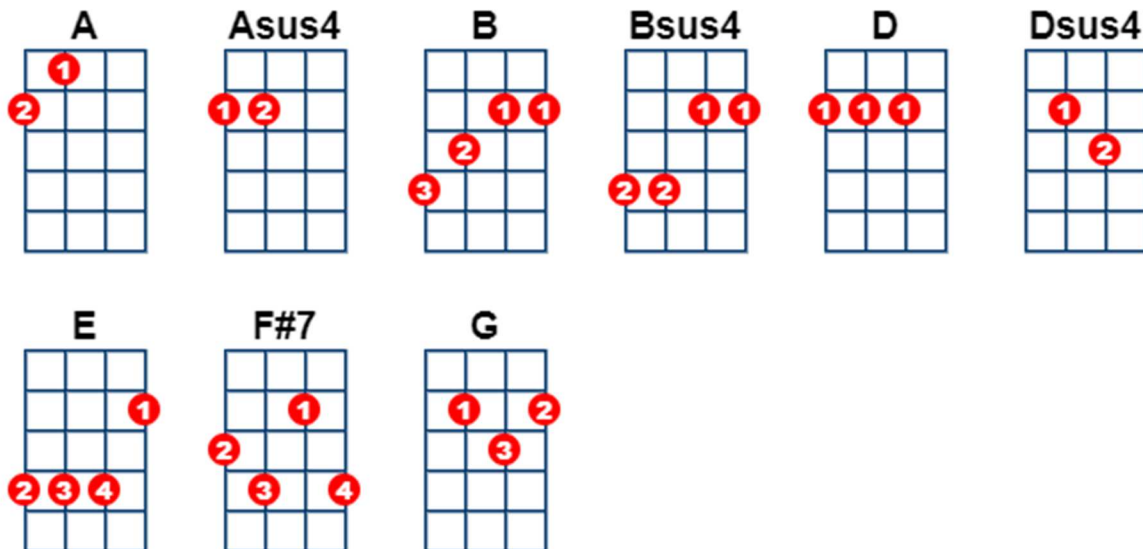


Pinball Wizard
